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- Step 1:** Select a paper for your design border. You will see both sides of the paper. Cut it 12"x3", then cut it into 3" squares, to give you 4 squares. Cut those squares in half to make triangles.
- Step 2:** Adhere your triangles to a 12"x3" base, alternating the colors, so that each one has the opposite color across from it. Then, trim your strip every 1" so you have 12 pieces.
- Step 3:** Rearrange your pieces onto another strip base out of order, but creating jagged peaks with your colors. Adhere them to that base. (**PLEASE** read my blog to see how this is done! QR Code at the bottom!)
- Step 4:** Cut 2 smaller strips of paper, measuring 12"x 1-1/2" and 12"x 3/4" from another designer paper and adhere to the edges of your layout base, with the more narrow strip to the right.



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Step 5: Adhere your peaks border to your page, just right of your left edge's strip. Adhere a border sticker or border to the seam between the fancy border and the strip if you would like.

Step 6: Mat your photos and adhere to the center of your empty space on the page.

Step 7: Embellish and journal on your page.
