





Original instructions posted in the Creative Memories Blog on 6/16/2023.

- Step 1: Select a paper for your 12x12 base. Select 3-4 different papers to cut your squares from. You can use either the Square Punch or your trimmer to create 1-3/4" squares. (I used the Deckle Blade to give it some texture.) You'll need about 27-30 squares.
- Step 2: Lay out your squares evenly, lining them up from the center edge of your base. Arrange them so that the colors are mixed up, if desired. Use Repositional Tape Runner to adhere them down. Trim off any hanging over the edge of your layout.
- Step 3: Mat your photo and adhere it to your layout. I did 3 photos, so arranged them to make them work.
- Step 4: Add some embellishments, either by punching some out, using stickers, or embellishments. Use Foam Squares if you want.
- Step 5: Journal.
