

2026 Summer Scrappy Camp - Adventure Awaits!

Challenge 19 - #scrappyhike19 (July 18, 2026)

(Instructions inspired by Meggan Jacks)



Step 1: Choose a 12x12 designer paper that you like both sides of and that work with your photos/layout. Take your Jumbo Circle Pattern from the Custom Cutting System and use the Red Blade along the outside edge to cut a circle out of the middle of that paper. Make EXTRA sure that your circle is lined up right in the center of the paper so that you have a good “shell” to work with for your outside pieces.

Step 2: Cut your circle into even quarters. Cut the “shell” of the paper you cut your circle from into even quarters.

Step 3: If you wish to punch out shapes along the corners of your “shell” pieces, you can do so. I used the Border Maker System to create the Festive Bursts. You will want to insert your pieces into your Border Maker Track and punch where appropriate by lining your cartridge housing up where you want the punches to be. Then turn your pieces 90° and punch the adjacent side. Repeat with each piece.

Step 4: Pair up each of your quartered circles with the shell pieces, flipping them opposite of each other so that 2 different patterns show. Use Tape Chips or welding techniques to put them together. You could also cut some 5-³/₄” squares to build your pieces on, which may make it more sturdy for you. You will need to trim off any excess. In the end, you will need 4 squares that measure 5-³/₄” x 5-³/₄”.

Step 5: Once you have all 4 of your pieces put together, adhere them to a 12 x 12 cardstock base.

Step 6: Create 4 photo mats to 4” x 4”. Trim your photos to 3-³/₄” x 3-³/₄” and adhere them on your page. Trim a small square to 2” x 2” and mat it on the same color as your base. Adhere to the center of your layout as show.

Step 7: Title, embellish, and journal as desired.
