

2026 Summer Scrappy Camp - Adventure Awaits! Challenge 21 - #scrappyhike21 (July 18, 2026)



Step 1: Use a 12" x 12" piece of cardstock for the base of your layout (Deep Sea Green in example). Gut if desired. Cut another piece of cardstock to 11" x 11" (Beige in my example). Gut that one if desired. Adhere to the 12x12 base. Cut another piece of cardstock to 10-1/2" x 10-1/2". (Don't gut this one.) Adhere on top of your last layer. (Navy in my example.)

Step 2: Use your largest circle in your custom cutting circle trio (not the jumbo circle), and your green blade in the center of your circle pattern to cut 2 circles from 4 different papers. You will end up with 8 circles.

Step 3: Quarter each circle. Arrange the pieces on your top layer of your layout, mixing and matching your patterns as shown in the example. Some will create a "fan" look, and others will have the quarters in the corners of their patterns. Or arrange them however you would like. You can skip the middle section since your photo(s) will cover it, or create more pieces to fill in if you need to there.

Step 4: Adhere your pieces down once you get it in a formation you like. I highly suggest using a repositionable tape runner so you can move your pieces as needed.

Step 5: Mat your photos according to the size you want your photo(s). I double matted my 5" x 7" photo with the pieces I gutted from the bases.

Step 6: Title, journal, and embellish as desired.
